RE: Physicians receive Academic Clinical appointments

Dr. Will Harrill and Dr. Merritt Seshul, both physicians at Carolina Ear, Nose & Throat Head and Neck Surgery Center, have each received Clinical Associate Professor appointments in the Department of Otolaryngology of Wake Forest University School of Medicine.

As Private practitioners in Hickory, Dr. Harrill and Dr. Seshul have remained active in Academic Medicine. Both were recently recognized for their clinical outcomes research following publication of their nationally recognized studies in nasal obstruction and Allergy therapy with their induction into the American Laryngological, Rhinological, and Otological Society.

Dr. Harrill has been an Ear, Nose & Throat physician in Hickory for 12 years, having joined Dr. Harry King in private practice following completion of his residency at the Baylor College of Medicine in Houston's Texas Medical Center. He currently serves as President and CEO of Carolina ENT/HNSC and Chairman of the Board of the Viewmont Surgery Center.

Dr Seshul joined Carolina ENT/HNSC in 2001 and currently serves as Medical Director of the practice's Allergy Division as well as serving at the state level as current President of the North Carolina/South Carolina Ear, Nose & Throat Society.

Carolina ENT/HNSC is based in Hickory and has offices in Lincolnton, Denver, and Mooresville and has recently expanded to 5 physicians and 2 physician's assistants. The practice has been a regional leader in outcomes research dedicated to quality of care and cost containment.
